David Burke gave a brief overview of the budget. It has a 3.21% increase.

Trustee Howell explained that the budget was a challenge this year. We have dedicated
employees that do not get paid on the high side.

Trustee Lang thanked all the department heads for helping to get the numbers down. He also
thanked David Burke.

Trustee Taylor agreed with Trustee Lang. It was a learning experience. David Burke did a great
job. We are in a good place.

Trustee Kronen asked the residents to look at the budget year to year. This is one of the leanest
budgets. The people who work for the village are very dedicated. I'm glad we are under the cap.
Thank you to all department heads for looking outside for monies.

Mayor Andino thanked David Burke. This is a very lean budget. We took into account what Covid
did to families. We need to look at staff salaries. We want them to be competitive and equitable.
We are optimistic with our projections.
