Item #1 Approval of Minutes – November 17, 2009

Member Pushkal motioned to approve the minutes of November 17, 2009 meeting was second by Member Nieminen and unanimously carried by the Board with a vote of 3-0.

Item #2 8 Fisher Avenue New Awning

Vincent Oddo of San Signs, representing Century Specialty Script, proposed to remove the existing awning and frame and replace it with a new awning. A new style “Shed” awning to match Martine’s Bake Shoppe, same height and same projection. The width will be different, and the bottom finished in egg crate. The frame will be painted in terra cotta to match the fabric color and the name of the store “Century Specialty Script” will be in white. Mr. Seminara asked if any decal or address will be on awning. Mr. Oddo said he was not proposing an address but if we want to add it on the awning, he can do that. Mr. Seminara suggested putting the number on either end of the awning. The number “8” will be on both ends of the awning, using the same font, white circle with terra cotta “8” in center about 5 inches. Mr. Seminara asked if there are any lights. Mr. Oddo said that this fabric does not illuminate and that no lights are proposed. Discussion regarding the store front took place. There being color, placement, etc. issues and that the owner is to appear before the Planning Board to address some issues related to the awning submission, the review board requested that the applicant return next month after they appear before the Architectural Review Board.

Item #3 29 Columbus Avenue Return

Applicant was not present.
