**Item #1 Approval of Minutes – March 16, 2010**  
**Member Pushkal motioned to approve the minutes of March 16, 2010 meeting was second by Member Nieminen and unanimously carried by the Board with a vote of 3-0.**

**Item #2 269 Columbus Avenue New Sign**

Chairwoman Ciaramella advised the owner of John Custom Tailor that the sign they are presenting is not to code. Chairwoman Ciaramella explained that the code only allows the name of the business “John Custom Tailor” the other information can be placed on the window, as long as it does not exceed 1/3 of the window. The lettering on the window can be either etched in the glass or vinyl lettering. The lettering cannot exceed 3 inches in height. Member Nieminen commented that “John Custom Tailor” explains what kind of business it is and also that it will look more elegant without the additional information. Chairwomen Ciaramella advised the applicant to return next month with a new rendering of the sign to scale along with a drawing for the sign on the window. The lettering on the sign should be a maximum of 9 inches and the window drawing should also be to scale. Also, they need to give a description on how the sign will be mounted on the façade. Applicant asked that since their sign is already up, can they keep it up until they get approval for the new sign. The applicant was granted 30 days to leave the sign up.

**Applicant will return next month.**

**Item #3 29 Columbus Avenue                      Return**

Mr. Kawer, owner of "Tuckahoe Paint and Glass" presented a revised drawing of the sign. He explained that they will take down the old wood and replace it with imitation stucco or Stow. They will paint the stucco red with a white line on the bottom and then use pin letters for the lettering. "Benjamin Moore" will be in white pin letters and "Kawer's Tuckahoe Paint & Glass" will be yellow pin letters.

**Motion to approve with the condition that the rendering submitted through email will be exact as to the description stated above for approval by Member Pushkal seconded by Member Nieminen and unanimously carried by the board with a vote of 3-0.**
